Protecting the Supply Chain

We took the decision a few months ago to increase our stock levels in order to mitigate any supply issues within our industry.

With all the news reports about product shortages in so many different industries due to supply or delivery issues, we felt this was the best way to protect our customers as far as we possibly could.

Hence, as we write this newsletter, we have good stock levels across our range of products so hope to be able to service your requirements as efficiently as usual.

Iron Roughneck Project

In partnership with MintMech of Penryn, Cornwall we have recently completed building the section of a geotechnical offshore drilling rig that handles the tools and drills. The new unit overcomes the need to use a person in what can be a very dangerous role and hence is critical for safety.

We were involved in the hydraulics assembly, remote control electrics, priming, painting, testing, packing and shipping.

Parts fabrication was handled by our sister company, Hercules CSMD, in Dartmouth and the whole project was completed in just one week and then shipped to the USA via air freight.



Focus on Training

We have worked in partnership with the NFPC for many years and recognise the value of their training pathway.

Two members of our team, Cameron Bacon and Matt Church have now completed their level 1 courses so we wish them the best of luck for the examinations at the end of September.

Also, Craig Langley attended the NFPC Apprentice Summer School and passed with flying colours.




205 Anchor Winch

We now have DNV Type Approval Certification for our entire range of lightweight aluminium anchor winches now that the largest 205 model has been added.

The 205 winch is essentially very similar to the rest of the range, just bigger. It is suitable for vessels with an equipment number up to 205.
