I wonder how many boats have been built at the yard over the past 100 years?

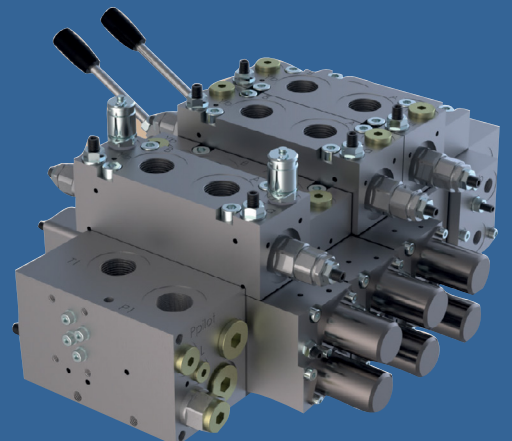


Hercules Valves
